Communication Policy

- TLC Gurukul readily offers flexible number of meetings but we request you to kindly book an appointment by call, text or in person to avoid any Inconvenience.
- Any information regarding the batch timing or photos/videos will be updated on the WhatsApp group. So, kindly make sure to share your WhatsApp number at the time of registration.
- We request parents to inform us through a call or message if the child is going to remain absent.
- Time & location for special events will be notified to parents well in advance.

No Valuables

- We request parents not to make kids wear any valuables including gold, silver, diamond, etc. at TLC Gurukul. In case of any loss, the organization doesn't take any responsibility.

Pick Up & Drop Off Policy

- We do not issue escort card as we believe in the "call policy". Your child will not be handed over to any new person (except parents or guardian) without an official call from your side.
- Parents are also expected to follow guidelines for pick up time & drop off time.
- Parents, please ensure that when you drop off or pick up your children Main Gate of school.
- Kids will be escorted by their trainers in a very safe and orderly manner.
- A text or call is expected from parents who wish to collect/drop off their kids before/after their official school timing.

Sickness Policy

- Open-ended questions will be asked which enables creative thinking and practical skills and knowledge of the students.

- The parents and TLC Gurukul need to make a collaborative effort to make a Plan for the development of the child. So, it is important for the parents to attend all the parenting sessions.
- A child's mind set & attitude is built at home. We request parents to create an environment at home as to where they can learn from.
- Any skill is developed after constant practice. We will need minimum of a year's time to bring about the change in a child's personality, behaviour and attitude. Kindly have patience and support your child's learning pace.
- Parents must cooperate with the management, other parents and kids in the Interest of their child's transformational journey at TLC Gurukul.

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES

Apart from the instructions in the school handbook we provide you set of instructions under different headings.

1. Parents must motivate their wards to participate in all activities and events.
2. Important dates for every activity/ competition are mentioned in activity planner.
3. Parents must send a Diary note on/before the due date to confirm wards participation as per asked.
4. No entries shall be taken for any competition after the final date given by text.
5. To maintain a fair participation, semi-finals will be conducted for all the Co- Curricular Activities by selection committee. Selection rights are reserved with the committee.
6. It is sole responsibility of the parents to prepare and send their ward ready for any activity/competition.
7. Judgement rights are reserved with judges and must be abide by all.
8. Winning Positions will be as per the number of final participants.
9. No student is allowed to exchange items with other students in lieu of cash or any kind of financial understanding.
10. It is compulsory to send healthy food and fruits in lunch box.
11. Exam is an integrated part of education system thus; it is expected to take it very seriously. If any student fails to appear in any written exam, it will not be taken by school.
In case of critical illness, medical certificate along with written application should be produced. Further decisions will be taken by the management.
12. For all written assessments only question paper pattern ie, marking scheme and type of questions will be given.
13. To improve students' ability few questions will be asked, in between the chapter, from class I onwards.
14. Answer sheets will be shown to students from class 10 onwards and their performance will be discussed with them before PTM.
15. It is compulsory for all the parents to attend all the PTMs arranged. If parents are not able to attend the PTM, prior diary note must be sent to class teacher.
16. Value Education is an integrated part of CBSE curriculum. As per the CCE guidelines and parameters given by CBSE, Value Education & Co-Scholastic Assessment of a child will be done.
17. All the schedules of Subject Enrichment Activities, Practical Examination and Pre-Board Examination of class X will be according to the schedule provided by CBSE.
18. Council Election Procedure and Investiture Ceremony will be conducted as per our rules.
 - Every Year the school selects and elects the students' council by voting through a complete democratic and fair process, to impart Leadership skill among students.
19. Every 4th saturday will be observed as a holiday.
