Sl. No.	GENERAL CONDITIONS - The school is directed to ensure that :
1.	The total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 12 (As per prescribed dimension) as per the number of class rooms reported during inspection and further increase shall be subjected to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws.
2.	Compliance of the points no. 1 to 11 may be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal, failing which due action will be taken.

Sl. No.	CONDITIONS FOR COMPLIANCE
1	1. The total number of sections shall be restricted to 12 and any further increase shall be subject to prior approval of the Board,subject to compliance with the affiliation bye laws and availability of rooms of >500 ft dimensions.
2	2. The school has submitted the Fire Safety Certificate without the seal and stamp of the issuing authority. The Fire Safety Certificate in the prescribed format, covering all the building blocks in the campus with proper seal and stamp of the issuing authority may be submitted within 3 months on SARAS portal.
3	3. The school has more than 1 building blocks in the campus. The school shall submit the correct number of building blocks and a revised building safety certificate from the competent govt authority certifying the structural stability of all these building blocks within 3 months and submit compliance.
4	4. The school shall construct ramps for CWSN outside all the building blocks in the campus within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS.
5	5. The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets which is too small for a wheel chair/walker to navigate.A temporary moveable seat has been put over the WC, which is not as per norms. The school shall construct separate toilets for CWSN boys and girls as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines issued by the board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS.
6	6. The science lab needs proper work stations with utilities and storage.The computer lab is under sized. the school shall shift the computer lab to a bigger room of prescribed dimensions and upgrade the science lab as per SoP issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS.

7	7. the library is not well stocked. A separate reading room is seen which is not well maintained(un white washed walls).The school does not have well developed outdoor sports facilities. The school shall upgrade its library and sports facilities as per SoPs of the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS.
8	8. Failure to submit compliance on the above points within prescribed time shall invite financial penalty against the school
9	9.The school is required to renew all the mandatory certificates from time to time and directed not to remove videography link in future.
10	10. The school shall ensure the training of its teachers with CoE Ajmer.
11	11. The school shall follow the SoPs of the Board for its labs, library and sports facilities.

The above is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

1. The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School is required to apply on online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy there of for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school to renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
"The school shall possess valid fire safety certificate and Building safety certificate during functioning of the school which shall be renewed from time to time as per norms".
